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HAMINA LNG OY – ADDITIONAL HP CAPACITY TO BE ALLOCATED IN JANUARY 2023

Starting on February 2023, the injection capacity to HP network will be increased from the current 200 MW to 250 MW. The additional 50 MW (1 200 MWh/d) will be allocated during January 2023 in accordance with the Terminal Rules of Hamina LNG Terminal (version 3.0 dated 30 June 2022), which can be found at: <https://www.haminalng.fi/materials/instructions-and-rules/>

The additional 50 MW capacity will be available as fixed capacity from 1 February 2023 until the end of the current gas year (30.9.2023). During January 2023, the additional 50 MW will be available for terminal users as intraday capacity considering the technical and operational constraints of the terminal. Hamina LNG reserves the right to modify the schedule below during the allocation process with a direct notification to all participants.

January 2023 allocation schedule

Jan 9th: Application period starts

Market parties can start submitting information on their desired amounts of additional HP injection capacity. The amounts must be sent to info@haminalng.fi by Friday 20 January 2023. An email with a clearly stated number between 0-1200 MWh/d and the desired distribution of products is sufficient. The products available for the additional capacity are (ref. terminal rules section 7.3):

- Month (2,491 €/MWh) for Feb-Sep 2023
- Quarter (2,192 €/MWh) for Apr-Sep 2023

If a market party that does not have a terminal services contract with Hamina LNG wishes to apply for HP injection capacity, the process is described in Appendix 1. Please note that also LNG storage capacity is required to receive HP injection capacity. Currently, there is 2 000 m³ of free LNG storage capacity and additional amounts can be discussed by contacting info@haminalng.fi.



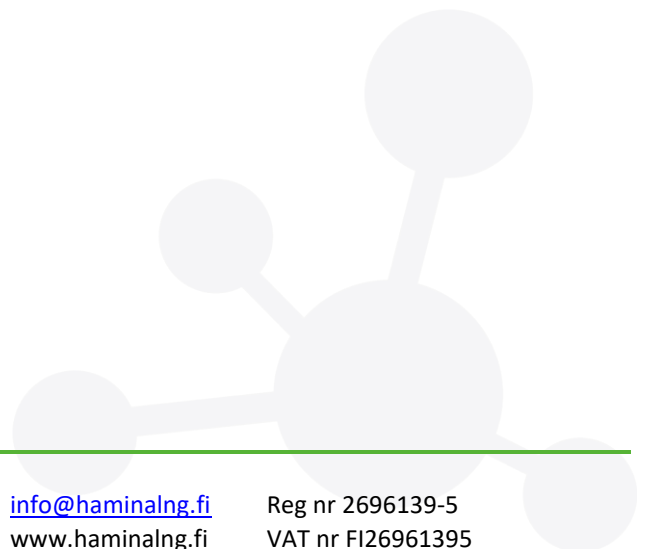
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Jan 20th: Application period ends, allocation starts

Hamina LNG will allocate the additional 50 MW capacity according to the terminal rules. The additional capacity allocated will be notified directly to all applicants. Required changes will be made to the Terminal Services Contracts by 27 January 2023.

Feb 1st: Additional fixed capacity is commissioned

The terminal users may nominate gas with the additional capacity they have received in the allocation.





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APPENDIX 1 – PROCESS FOR NEW TERMINAL USERS

- 1) To begin the application process, send the following documents to Hamina LNG's email info@haminalng.fi with the subject "Hamina LNG application documents"
 - a) Copy of an up-to-date trade register extract
 - b) Copy of the licence of a registered user of natural gas (if needed for the use of Terminal services)
 - c) Written confirmation that the applicant has the necessary LNG sources and vessel(s) suitable for delivering LNG to Hamina LNG Terminal
 - d) Audited financial statements from the last 3 years, or, if the company has been founded more recently, since the founding of the company
 - e) Notice to the Operator regarding whether the intended use of LNG is taxable under the Finnish act on Excise Tax (189/2010, as amended) and possible tax exemption decision document for non-taxable deliveries
- 2) Hamina LNG responds with a Binding Capacity Booking form and a draft of the Terminal Services Contract (TSC).
- 3) Fill out the Binding Capacity Booking form and send it to info@haminalng.fi.
- 4) Hamina LNG informs about the next steps of the process directly.
